

Answers to FAQs about CFA

- CFA does not require uniforms. We ask for students to wear modest dress.
- Lunches at CFA: Students in may bring food from home. They have access to microwaves. They have the option to order food from places like Bojangles, Village Inn, and Wendy's.
- New families coming from the public school system may be eligible for the North Carolina Opportunity Scholarship. You can find more info about this at NCSEAA.edu.
- We use a variety of curriculum. (Abeka, Veritas Press, Bob Jones, Shurley Grammar, Saxon, Apologia)
- Our school day is from 9:00-3:00. You may drop off your student as early as 7:30 AM. We ask that all students are picked up by 3:15 unless approved by administration. There is no after school care.
- Cell phones and other electronic devices are not allowed for personal use during the school day.
- We offer the following sports: Girls- Volleyball, Cross Country, Basketball
Boys- Soccer, Cross Country, Basketball, Baseball
- We have a designated parking area for student drivers.
- Each spring, students in K-11th grades take standardized tests. We do not have EOG tests.
- Every CFA student has a Bible class each day and participates in chapel once a week.
- We allow various translations of the Bible. Students may use their preferred translation.
- We send a weekly email to keep parents updated on what is happening at CFA.
- We have a school-wide software program called Gradelink to help parents and students stay up to date academically.
